



## **NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF NOMINATION PERIOD**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nomination Period for non-incumbent candidates for seats in District 4 and City Treasure for the General Municipal Election on November 3, 2020 has been extended five days pursuant to Elections Code Section 10225.

Interested residents must file nomination papers for the General Municipal Election by the new deadline, August 12, 2020, during normal business hours (7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.).

The filing period was extended beyond the initial August 6, 2020 deadline because Incumbent Bonnie Wright and Judith Oltman did not file nomination papers. The filing period for incumbents is now closed. Any Hemet resident age 18 or older who is eligible to hold office and who is registered to vote at the time nomination papers are issued can file nomination papers.
