Services Eligibility Requirements

- Residing in Riverside County
- Ages 24 and under
- Actively experiencing homelessness, at risk of homelessness, in imminent danger or unsafe situation that would lead to homelessness



Housing Eligibility Requirements

- Residing in Riverside County
- Ages 18-24
- Actively experiencing homelessness, at risk of homelessness, in imminent danger or unsafe situation that would lead to homelessness

**Youth who meet housing eligibility requirements, are able to access youth navigators on site to connect to housing.*

3 Get referred to housing and supportive services!

Visit a drop-in center **ask to meet with the youth housing navigator on site**. Explain your situation to get guidance on what housing options are available. From there, get entered into the Coordinated Entry System (CES) utilized to make housing referrals.

Other housing services:

- security deposit
- utility deposit
- assistance with moving costs

If you do not need housing connection, the center is available to support with **other supportive services including:**

- transportation (bus passes)
- mental health services
- employment assistance and job training
- education services
- food
- life skills training
