

ALCOHOL REGULATIONS

ABC General Categories:

1. **Off-sale License (carry out sales)**
 - a. Liquor stores
 - b. Liquor retailers (Bev-Mo, etc.)
 - c. Supermarkets
 - d. Convenience stores
 - e. Gas-station Mini-Marts
 - f. Specialty stores (wine store, etc)
2. **On-sale License**
 - Restaurants
 - Bars
 - Wineries and Micro-breweries
 - **Beer & Wine sales**
 - Offsite – Type 20 license
 - On-site (restaurant) Type 41
 - **Liquor sales (distilled spirits)**
 - Offsite- Type 21 license
 - On-site- (Restaurants) –Type 47
 - On-site (bars) Type 48
 - Clubs (members & guests only) – Type 51
 - **Instructional tasting** – Onsite – Type 86 license
 - **Special events that serve alcohol (one-day license)**

Existing City of Hemet Code Requirements: (not including Specific Plans)

- Bars, nightclubs and dance halls: requires an Administrative Use Permit (AUP), if live entertainment included a CUP is required
- Restaurants: alcohol sales are permitted by right, live entertainment requires a CUP
- Micro-brewery or Wine Bar: requires a CUP
- Liquor store or Convenience store: Permitted by right
- Gas Station Mini-Mart: requires a CUP as part of the Gas Station
- Pharmacy (Walgreen's etc.) that sells beer & wine, alcohol: permitted by right
- No formal or separate process is in place for reviewing alcoholic beverage permits other than to check the zoning and have Police review for instances of over-concentration.
- No process or code requirements are in place for the granting of alcohol to be served at special events, other than ABC requirements.
- No special standards, findings or separation requirements under the current zoning
- No "social host" ordinance
